The Valley City Speech Team won their 4th consecutive state title on Saturday, April 17th at Jamestown High School. 25 Valley City entries brought home state medals. Junior, Vismaya Jacob, was named the champion of Poetry Interpretation. She is the 47th State champion in Valley City High School Speech Team history.

The Valley City High School Speech Team also competed at the North Dakota Roughrider District Speech tournament for a chance to compete at the National Speech and Debate Tournament. 12 Valley City High School students qualified to compete, a new school record.
